
One last thing - you said "when people attack our "identity" we get defensive, unless we're open to hearing the perspectives of others etc.".

Is it really sad the 'white man" is being called to count & viewed with suspicion or is it deserved? With all that's occurred over the history of colonialization have 'white men' demonstrated their trustworthiness or broken treaties, raped, stolen & nearly extinguished Indigenous Peoples? Are "white men" not still currently doing so? Heck "white men" created "white men" can they now not be held accountable to dismantle it & them not whine or need to be coddled & defended by "white" women? "White men" have "white centered" western medicine to go to....& most have insurance. It's what "white men" created it's all based on their bodies & controlled & regulated by "white men" for the most part, it puts immense wealth in "white men's" pockets too. If "white men" don't like it fight to change it, like our Indigenous & BIPOC are & have to lift bans & fight attacks on their Traditional Practices & even languages. I for one sure wish they would! It nearly killed me! Then I was guided to plant medicines myself & have found healing.

Fact is many of the Practices, Medicines are being used inappropriately, irresponsibly, & for profit which does additional harm & adds additional strain on already strained Indigenous cultures. Where do they go to turn for the past & now ongoing daily harm of racism & now they get to see "white men" selling what was once free & your demonized (sometimes still) identity & practices. Just how would you feel in that skin? With all that was taken now being flaunted in your face & offered only at a price & from a face which looks remarkably similar to who killed your Grandfather or raped Grandmother? Who's burning your

too. Makes it challenging to retrace & reweave those threads... I figure in this case flying to Europe might be cheaper & leave less footprint in so many ways.

Are forever to be condemned? Hmmm well... I'll refer you here to discern where I stand on that... It's a Reckoning Time for us ALL. https://m.facebook.com/story.php? story_fbid=10156970208072005&id=91116257004

I'd ask you to consider how long has it been the "white man's" been oppressing? How long has it been since slavery ended.... and how long did it go on is it STILL going on?? To build our computers? If you truly wish peace you got a long way to go to being a Peace Maker, in my lineage I tapped & follow the example, stories & teachings of the Peace Pilgrim, I highly recommend.

Unity in Diversity vs Borg like further assimilation is my Desire & Goal not no white-washed CIA/UN transhumanism agenda.

We should probably do a Live just on this one topic alone. Because there is so much to unravel. But let me seen if I can better explain my position here.

First, we have the persistent, underlying current of racial tension in this country. A tension, btw, that the 50+ years following the Civil Rights movement did little to eradicate. (see my thoughts on that above, or in the vid)

Then we have the murder of a black man by a white cop with 4 police "accomplices" (for lack of a better term).

Now if this just occurred organically, with no pre-meditation, that's a horrible enough occurrence.

But IF this WERE a premeditated/ orchestrated murder, that points to an even more insidious, *institutionally driven* hate. And that is truly horrifying, How is THAT ever eradicated?

We might ask the very same question about the murder of MLK. Do we think that James Earl Ray acted alone, or was he rather the fall guy in a larger plot? I don't "know", I just observe and ask questions. But 50+ years of stalled race relations progress sure hints of an institutionally driven hate agenda to me.
